ORDINANCE NO. 12, 2010

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 4-2010, WHICH ESTABLISHED A FINANCING MECHANISM FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW CITY HALL COMPLEX

WHEREAS, the City Council (the "City Council") of the City of Alamosa, Colorado (the "City") has received a petition for the repeal of City of Alamosa Ordinance No. 4-2010; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 4-2010 approved documents and established maximum terms for a lease purchase financing of a municipal complex facility including a new city hall and library, and renovation of the current city hall/library/fire department building for police and fire use; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has re-considered Ordinance No. 4-2010 and determines that it is in the best interests of the City to repeal the Ordinance and not to submit it to an election of the registered electors in the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Alamosa, Colorado:

Ordinance No. 4-2010 is repealed in its entirety.

INTRODUCED, READ AND APPROVED on first reading the 2nd day of June, 2010, and ordered published as provided by law with notice of a public hearing to be held for consideration of the adoption of said Ordinance on the 16th day of June, 2010, at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, or on such subsequent date to which the public hearing or Council consideration may be continued.
