

Recommendation

Adopt Resolution No. 16, 2010 amending the presumptive fine schedule.

Background

The City's traffic fines were last evaluated in 2005. Since that time, numerous other jurisdictions, including the State Courts, have increased substantially.

The purpose of a fine is to serve as a deterrent to discourage a particular action. If penalty amounts are not at a sufficient level to cause a person to contemplate a change in behavior, that penalty loses its effectiveness. We have reached a point where I believe that the penalty needs increased to meet this goal.

It is also appropriate that Municipal Court fines be amended to better match State levels. For some offenses, this will mean an increase; for others it remains the same.

Issue Before the Council

Does Council wish to adopt the proposed Resolution?

Alternatives

- 1) Adopt Resolution No. 16, 2010 as presented.
- 2) Adopt Resolution No. 16, 2010 with amendments
- 3) Do not adopt this Resolution, and continue operating under the existing fine schedule.

Fiscal Impact

It is important to remember that fines are meant as a penalty and behavior deterrent, and should not be considered as a means of generating revenue. With that said, it's certainly reasonable to project that revenues will increase to some degree.

Legal Opinion

Counselor Schwiesow will be available at the meeting if needed.

Conclusion

Having presumptive fines established in a meaningful amount is critical for successful operation of the Municipal Court. The proposed changes reflect an appropriate penalty as well as move us into a similar comparison to other jurisdictions.

RESOLUTION NO 16, 2010

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDED SCHEDULE
OF PRESUMPTIVE FINES FOR VIOLATION OF THE
CODE OF ORDINANCES OF ALAMOSA, COLORADO**

WHEREAS, the *schedule of Fines for Violations of the Code of Ordinances of Alamosa, Colorado* has not been amended to reflect the changes in the standard of living for five years; and

WHEREAS, in order for the imposition of a fine to serve adequately as a penalty and deterrent for violations of the Code, the amount of the fine should bear a reasonable relationship to the state of the economy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Alamosa, Colorado:

The *Schedule of Fines* attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference for violations of the *Code of Ordinances for the City of Alamosa, Colorado*, is hereby adopted, as the presumptive schedule of fines for application in Municipal Court. These fines shall be applied unless the Court makes specific findings concerning aggravating or mitigating factors which warrant deviation from this schedule in any given case.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
