HOUSING SURVEY NOW UNDERWAY

Seeks Select Residents' Input Regarding Housing Conditions and Costs

ALAMOSA, Colorado (May 20, 2010) - The City of Alamosa is conducting a Housing Survey as part of a Housing Study to analyze housing conditions and costs in town. A select number of Alamosa residents have been chosen to participate in the survey. Residents will be notified of their selection via a letter from Mayor Kathleen Rogers, which should arrive in mailboxes around May 24th. The survey is anonymous, takes only a few minutes to complete and all responses are confidential.

Only one member of each selected household needs to respond and the easiest way to do this is via the Internet. To take the survey, type the following link into your Internet browser: <http://www.zoomerang.com/Survey/WEB22AMKD9YEVJ>. Selected participants will have received a Survey ID number inside their letter and by entering this ID number & completing the survey, they will be entered into a drawing for a \$50 Safeway gift card.

Selected residents who do not complete the Internet survey in 14 days will receive a paper copy of the survey in the mail. Those without a home computer or access to the Internet may take the survey using public computers at the Southern Peaks Library at 423 4th St. in Alamosa.

According to Mayor Rogers, "Your survey answers will help our community make decisions that affect you, your neighbors and our economy. The information gained from this study will help us effectively plan for our future housing and community needs."

Mayor Rogers strongly encouraged participation by adding, "Your participation is important and unique because only a small number of people have been randomly chosen to complete the questionnaire. Please help us by responding promptly."
