The City of Alamosa Municipal Court will begin posting a weekly list of outstanding municipal arrest warrants on the City of Alamosa's website, with hard copies maintained at City Hall and the Police Department. The information contained in these records is public information and it is our hope that through publication, we can reduce the number of outstanding arrest warrants for those who have failed to appear in court and collect fines owed to the City as a result of a court order.

As a kickoff to this program, Judge Powell has agreed to hold a special court hearing date on November 15, 2011 between 1:30 and 4:30 p.m. at 300 Hunt Ave. for those with current and outstanding arrest warrants. Defendants with City of Alamosa Municipal Court arrest warrants are invited to appear before Judge Powell on this date/time to be arraigned, seek a newly scheduled court appearance date, or to pay fines owed the court in lieu of being arrested and going straight to jail. Note: If you are contacted by police at any time before or after this court hearing date and before you are able to resolve the matter you may be arrested and transported to jail for bonding. If you suspect you may have an outstanding warrant from Municipal Court please call the City of Alamosa Municipal court at (719) 589-2272. Court employees will let you know whether or not you have an outstanding warrant and how to take care of it.

Reminder: Outstanding municipal arrest warrants will be publicized. Take this opportunity to NOT be on this list. Act now!
