

ALAMOSA RECYCLING CENTER

Where: Ross & 8th Ave. (Next to water tower, across from Head Start)

When: Open 24 hours a day 7 days a week.
Labeled drop areas are accessed through holes in the fence.
Gates are open **M-F 8:00 am – 3:30 pm.**



Newspaper: Remove newspaper from bags, boxes, or bindings (rubber bands) and place in bin.

Office Paper: Includes white copy paper, shredded paper, typing paper, computer paper, and white envelopes
NO Colored Paper!!!

Magazines: Place magazine and glossy paper in this bin. Removing them first from bags or boxes.

Cardboard: Please flatten boxes. (Please see below for **NOT** acceptable types of boxes.)

PETE #1 Plastic: This includes clear bottles as well as bottles with green, blue, or amber tint. (i.e. pop bottles)

HDPE #2 Colored Plastic: This bin is for solid colored plastic such as laundry detergent bottles. Please rinse and remove lids. NO engine oil or antifreeze bottles due to hazardous residues.

HDPE # 2 Natural Plastic: This bin contains natural, frosted, or semi-opaque plastics such as milk jugs. Please rinse and remove lids.

Steel Cans: Please rinse. Labels are acceptable.

Aluminum: Please rinse all cans

What CANNOT Be Recycled

- Glass
- Plastic bags
- Oil containers
- Window panes
- Lumber
- Paper bags
- Antifreeze containers
- Vases/light bulbs
- Phone books
- Trash
- Chipboard
- Styrofoam
